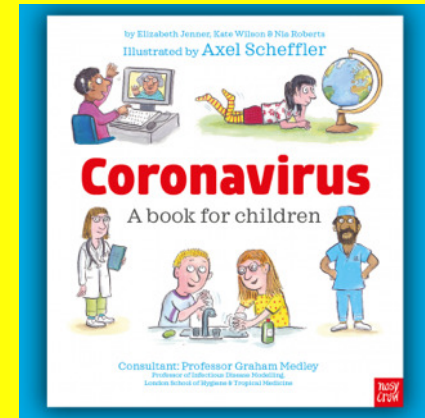

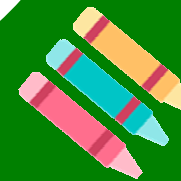
Alex Scheffler has illustrated a digital book to help explain the current crisis to children. It is free to download, and although more for primary age children it is still helpful.
