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Playdough Recipe

- 1 cup of plain flour
- 1 cup of oil
- 1 cup of hot water
- 2 tsp of cream of tartar
- ½ cup of salt
- Food colouring

1. Mix the dry ingredients together.
2. Add the hot water, oil and food colouring to the dry ingredients, and mix together with a spoon.
3. Tip onto a floured surface and knead until smooth.

Store in a plastic freezer bag in the fridge to keep it fresh.
